Founded in 2009 as an outreach ministry of the Presbyterian Church of the Covenant. EDGE For Tomorrow (EFT) began with a small after-school program serving 5-7 students. Since becoming an independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit in 2019, EFT has grown into a beacon of hope for students from underserved communities. We now serve 45 students annually and aim to expand to 60+ by the 2026-2027 school year.
