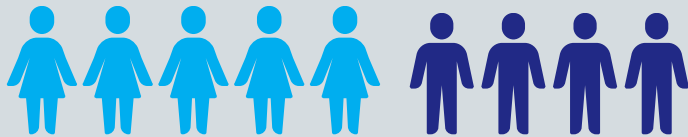
Elevating Excellence Exploring Females in Flight

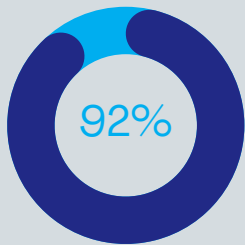


87% of students identify as Black and 98% are Minorities

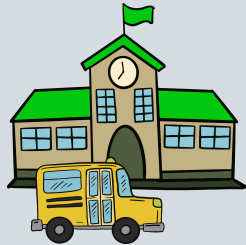


49% of students are Male and 51% are Female

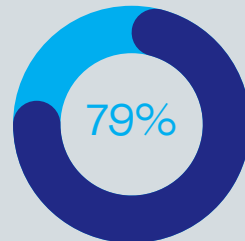

Students who learned something new in STEM

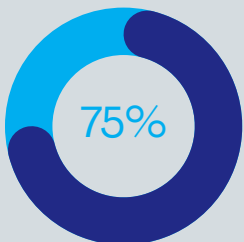

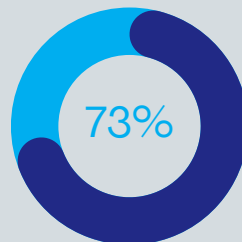

Students who declared STEM majors



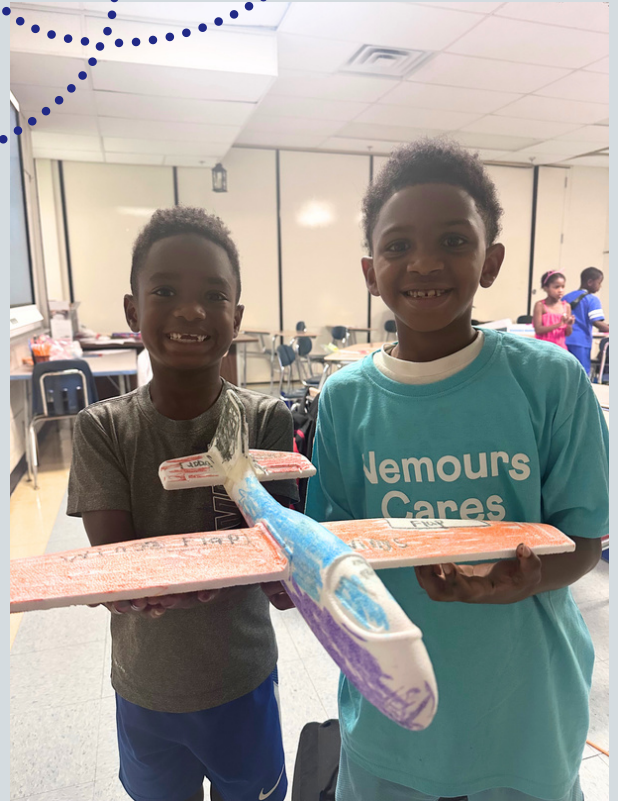

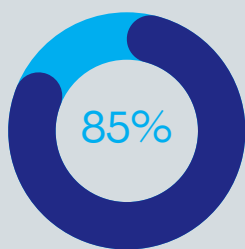

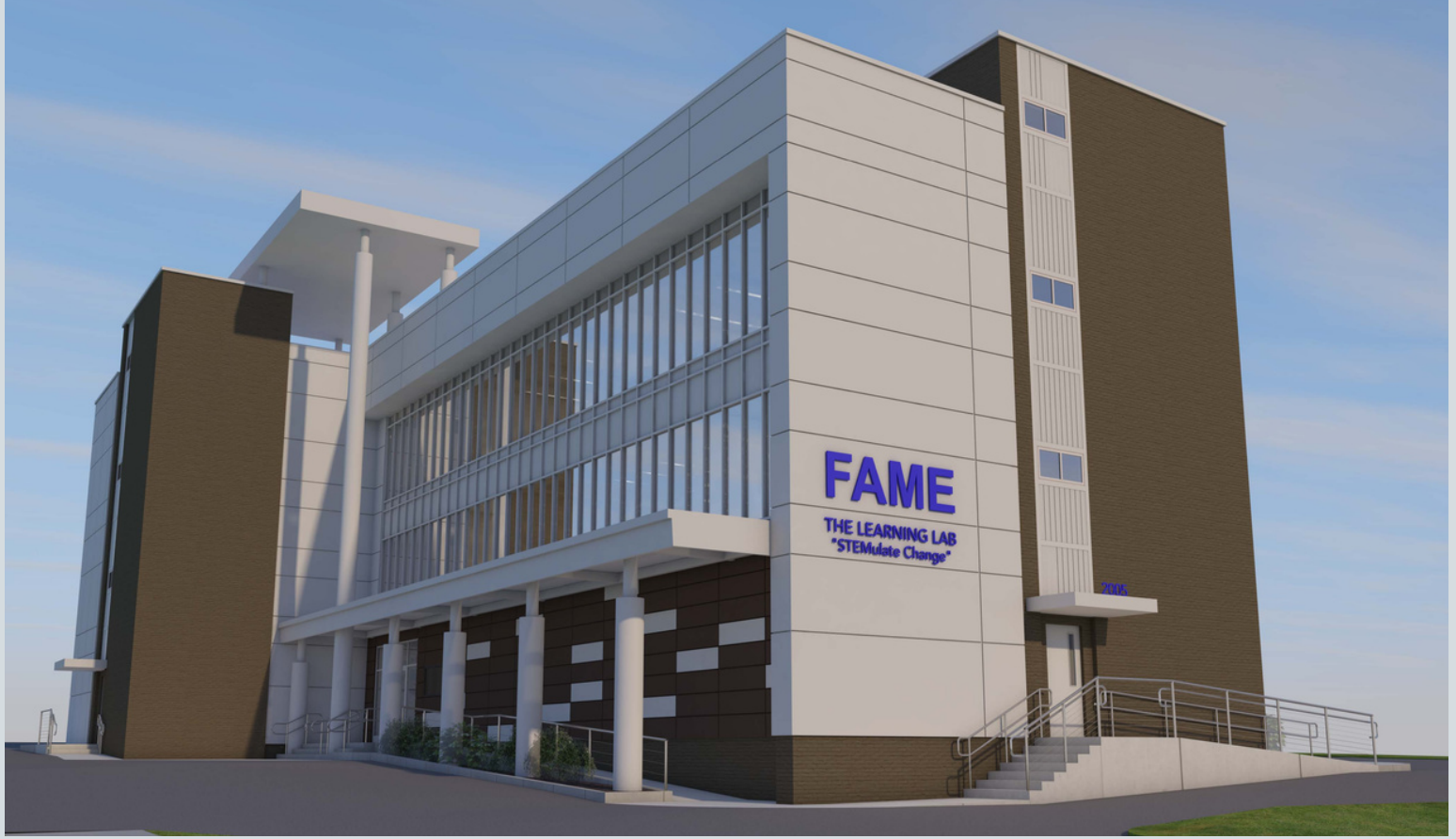
